Guidance on Completing your wedding application form.

Names: please include your Christian name, all middle names and surname. If you have changed your name by deed poll please bring proof of this.

Age at date of wedding: this should be self-explanatory.

Occupation: please ask the vicar's advice on euphemisms.

Father: you may choose to fill in this section with your father's name, (please include middle names) or to substitute your step-father if he is married to your mother - in which case you should add 'step-father' after his name; or if you have been legally adopted you may substitute your adoptive father's name, but no not need to add adopted or similar afterwards, or if you wish you may leave it blank.

Father's occupation: please do not leave this blank unless the section showing father's name is also blank.

Address: please include your postcode. If your address changes you must inform the vicar immediately. This may affect your right to be married.

Phone number: this is to help us contact you, and will be added to the list of wedding couples, marriages and dates given to the organists and the churchwardens and responsible persons in each church. By filling in this section you are consenting to this.

Email address: this is purely to facilitate communication in case we can;t get in touch with you by phone. The email newsletter is no longer in existence.

Parish Church: your Church of England parish church, not necessarily the nearest church. Look at the website www.achurchnearyou.com and enter your postcode to find out which parish you live in.

Rings: if you are both having a wedding ring insert the number 2.

The sections at the bottom of the page indicate HOW you will get married ie which legal preliminaries you will complete - BANNES, COMMON LICENCE, SUPERINTENDENT REGISTRARS CERTIFICATES, ARCHBISHOP'S LICENCE, or which you already have qualified by - BANNES BY RESIDENCE, OR BY QUALIFYING CONNECTION. These are all explained on the website in some detail.

Videos and Audio Recording.

Signing the form indicates that you know and are in agreement that video and audio recording are not permitted, and that you promise not to pressure the vicar directly or indirectly to allow this.

If you ask nicely audio recording may be permitted at the rehearsal.

Signature: please ensure both parties sign the application form, although not normally necessary this is required in these parishes due to the prohibition on video and audio recording.
